

## **One Golf Club – Proposal to EPIC**

### **What is One Golf Club?**

Since 2007 the One Golf Club Concept is an innovative solution to playing golf. They have golf professionals, event managers and a host of outstanding golf clubs for the member to utilise and enjoy. Members can also use the practice facilities and golf simulators on the portfolio. One Golf Club provides their members use of their portfolio courses for a single annual subscription. No more green fees, vouchers, loyalty cards or points-based pay and play. One Golf Club have 31 courses throughout Greater London and continue to add to our portfolio.

The concept is a member only golf reservation service allowing members to play a wide variety of courses. Tee times are not pre-booked. The members call the course from the list on the members only website (list of current courses is attached) and book the tee time they wish to play. Booking details are on the website.

Each tee is for up to 4 players so only 1 member needs to book the tee. Additional members can simply add their names to that tee time via the website if they wish to join. Or can create a new tee time. On arrival the members show their One Golf Club membership card in the pro shop and do not pay a green fee. Buggies and guests are allowed and member guest rates.

### **What does it Cost?**

Membership for EPIC will commence on 1st March rather than 1st of May. Membership will expire 30th April 2021. So 14 months membership for price of 12. The subscription for 2020/21 will be £550 plus VAT.

### **Where can you Play?**

I have attached a list of all One Golf Club affiliated golf clubs. In addition we have added Langley Park & Croham Hurst, two great private members clubs in Surrey. We will renew with Burhill/Brocket Hall/Moor Park as before but are looking to add Foxhills and possibly Denham. The course list will grow from 33 to approximately 40 by May 2020.

### **What is the benefit to EPIC?**

If we have a number of members then this will allow us to utilise One Golf Clubs preferred rates if we wished to arrange events at any of their affiliated clubs. There are other bonuses such as free practice balls etc

If the above is of interest to any member please reply to me using this email and I will compile a list of interested members.

Finally, if the group wished to join enmass (40+) then I am happy to do the Captains day as compliments of One Golf Club. That's £5500 which is a better route for both of us as everyone that joins effectively gets the £115 off for the Captains day. I think that could work with the course list we have.
